- Saree Draping for those who would like to learn; it's also interesting to just watch!
- Free time for shopping . Those who do not want to shop can visit a couple of art galleries in the area or visit the Prince of Wales Museum (Chhatrapati Shivaji Vastu Sangrahalya)
- Return to hotel
