The People of Mumbai - Many Faiths, Many Cultures (8:00 am to 5:00 pm)

This tour introduces you to Mumbai's diverse people - their clothes, religion, food and ways of life. We will start with a look at the culture and customs of the Kolis (the fisher folk who were the original inhabitants of Mumbai) and the Parsis (the Zoroastrians who have played a major role in the city's history). We will then visit St. Thomas Cathedral, one of the oldest Anglican Churches in Mumbai, with an active Christian community that is very much a part of the city. Two Jewish communities, the Baghdadi Jews and the Bene-Israel have been associated with the city in the past- and have given the city many of its important landmarks. The tour takes you to one of the oldest synagogues in Mumbai. Mumbai has a large Muslim population, including Bohras, Khojas, Memons and several other communities. We will drive through the by-lanes of Mohammed Ali Road for a glimpse of their lives. And, for a look at the Hindu and Jain community, we'll take you to see the Banganga water tank and the Jain temple in the area.

Route: Transfer to Marine drive (see fishing boats in harbour and learn about the fisherfolk) - drive past Cuffe Parade fishing village and naval forces residential area - visit St Thomas Cathedral - drive to Malabar Hill - see Tower of Silence and learn about Parsis - visit Jain Temple - visit Banganga Temple Tank - Lunch - drive through Mohamed Ali Road and colourful bazaar area - visit Magen David Synagogue - optional visit to Bhau Daji lad Museum (which has history of Mumbai and its community) - return to hotel
